- <u>Hospitality Room.</u> The Hospitality Room assignment is to be determined. The Hospitality Room will open Wednesday September 27 and be open from 7AM each day of the reunion and close about Midnight or until the last man is standing. Snacks and drinks will be provided. You are invited to bring memorabilia from your Stonewall Jackson experience to share with other shipmates. We will be selling raffle tickets including the 50-50 raffle in the Hospitality Room. It will be closed during functions such as the Welcome Aboard, Memorial Service, and the Banquet.
- <u>Welcome Aboard</u>. Cost: \$20.00. The Welcome Aboard party is scheduled for Wednesday the September 27th from 4:30 to 7:00PM, room TBD. It's a stand up mixer type of function with appetizers, and a Cash Bar.

- <u>Memorial Service</u>. We will have a Memorial Service on Friday September 29th 10:00AM till noon at the Cold War Area of Patriot's Point. Our Memorial Bench also be dedicated at this event.

 - We will notify the winner and hotel right after the drawing.
 - The winner is responsible to make the proper arrangements with the hotel.
